Mayor Bennett called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M. On a motion by Mayor Wasowicz and seconded by Mayor Straz the September 29th, 2022 Meeting Minutes were approved.

Executive Director's Report

Ms. Smith noted that the 2022 meeting schedule will be available at the end of December. She also noted that the SCM will not be hosting a Joint Municipal Auction this Fall because the municipalities will not have their items available for auction until sometime in 2022. Ms. Smith gave an update on the LGDF legislative issue. Ms. Smith reminded the Mayors that it's important that they reach out their General Assembly Members regarding the LGDF legislative issue and all important legislative matters. Ms. Smith noted that the SCM 2022 Golf Outing will be moved to either June or July because Gleneagles will seize hosting golf on July 31, 2022. Ms. Smith reminded the Mayors of the November 1st call with Cook County.
